### Goals

### Grading and criteria

Grades are based on attendance. Commitment to the ensemble's goals may influence a grade. Any reduction of grade will be discussed between the individual and Mr. Barnes. Attendance is required at all camps, rehearsals, and events. Students with conflicts should e-mail the Secretary/Librarian, drum majors, AND Mr. Barnes before the conflict, or as soon as possible afterward. At the minimum, the student with a conflict should call the Secretary/Librarian cell phone so we know the person is safe. The band leadership does not give permission to miss; students with conflicts should decide what is important enough to miss marching band and let the above people know. Grades will be submitted as appropriate to music registration. Participants enrolled in MUS 014 (six terms of MUS 01X are required for M6 credit) are required to write a one-page biography on one composer or arranger performed that semester.
