- **B.** There are **no make-ups for Interros(quizzes**). (The lowest grade or one missed quizz will be dropped.) The geography quizz will NOT be dropped.
- C. I fully expect all students to attend class and to participate in work done in class. 10% of your final grade is allotted to this category and it all depends on YOU. In order to participate well in class, homework assignments must be carefully completed prior to the start of class each and every class. 15% of your final grade is allotted to this category...AND, AGAIN, IT ALL DEPENDS ON YOU. YOU AND YOU ALONE CONTROL 25% of your final grade...with discipline and a conscientious attitude. Please note that homework submitted late is of no interest to me. Students should be prepared to spend between 6-10 hours per week for this class, outside of the classroom...if you are not, ask yourself why not?
- **D.** Three absences will be allowed. Attendance is always taken --- regardless of the reason for the absence or your presentation of doctor's notes. Please inform me (and the *Office of Learning Services*) if you have a chronic health problem. Should you experience a family tragedy in the course of this semester (Heavens Forbid !!!), the Dean's Office should be informed of your absence so that all your instructors will be "au courant". Beginning with the 4<sup>th</sup> absence, your oral participation grade will be lowered ½ letter grade **for each class missed**: i.e., a B will be changed to a B-, etc.
