Grading and criteria: Since some people have never been in a marching band, grades are based mostly based on attendance. The grade may also be influenced by a student's commitment to the ensemble's goals. Any reduction of grade will be discussed between the individual and Mr. Barnes. Attendance is required at all camps, rehearsals, and events. The band leadership does not give "permission" to miss; students with conflicts should decide what is important enough to miss marching band and let the above people know.

Weekday Practices- Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:00-6:00pm Home Football Game Practices- 10:00am

To be considered "on time" for GMB practices and events, you must be at the field/practice area/meeting area no later than the call time for that event. It is very important that you notify <u>Katie</u>, the <u>Drum Majors</u>, <u>Prof. Barnes</u>, and your <u>Section Leader</u> when you must miss a practice or event, even if you do not have an excuse to do so. Knowing why someone is missing or running late is important – because it helps us know you are safe and allows us to adjust plans to keep the rest of the ensemble running smoothly. Please remember that we all work together to make performances happen. When you are missing, it is noticeable.

If you miss 3 rehearsals (excused or not), or a performance without sufficient notice and reason, Prof. Barnes may reassign you or require you to drop this course.

Expected Conflicts

We need to know ALL your regular fall conflicts, as soon as possible. To ensure we know you are OK when you are not at GMB rehearsals and events, we ask you to do the following by the start of Band Camp, or (if you need to drop/add) the start of Mini-Band Camp.

If you have Tuesday or Thursday classes that end at 3:45 pm on North Campus, please e-mail Katie, stkam14, with the 3:45 class days, the course number, and the professor's name.

If you have a lab that "ends" at 3:45, please e-mail Katie, stkam14, to let her know the day of the week you have a lab. However, if a lab is running significantly over time, we ask that you also text her to let her know you will be running particularly late.

If your family has planned a special fall event during one of the GMB rehearsals or events, please let Katie, the Drum Majors, Prof. Barnes, and your Section Leader know by the start of Band Camp.

Unexpected Conflicts

If you have an unexpected, non-emergency, family event or class requirement preventing you from being at a rehearsal or an event, it is important that you notify Katie, the Drum Majors, Professor Barnes, and your Section Leader in advance. Even with notice, these conflicts may still count as unexcused absences.

Work is not a reason to miss a practice or performance.

Illness Conflicts

If you are ill and unable to attend a practice or performance please, get help first! When you are safe, e-mail or text Katie, the Drum Majors, Professor Barnes, and your section leader. An excused illness absence requires a **note from the Health Center or a doctor**. Otherwise the absence will be unexcused. Your note is due to Katie by the third practice after a missed practice or event. Otherwise your absence will be unexcused.

In the event of a catastrophic illness, we would appreciate a text or phone call from a friend or family member to Katie, the Drum Majors, Prof. Barnes, or your Section Leader.
