As part of the 2014-2015 IN FOCUS program on Peace and Justice, the IN FOCUS Center for Investigation is offering this Colloquium in Peace and Justice. The program will consist of presentations in which faculty members discuss their research related to the overarching theme of Peace (War) and Justice. The presentations cover a wide variety of topics and disciplines and highlight the research of Moravian faculty.

This is a quarter unit course. In order to earn 0.25 units for this course, students will be required to attend five of seven presentations. In addition to attending these talks, students will be required to participate in discussion and submit at the end of the semester a six-page reflective paper that connects five or more of the attended presentations.
